


2024 Post-graduate programme alumni survey



The GRÓ alumni survey was conducted as part of the evaluation. Out of the 471 postgraduate fellows between 2018 and 2023, more than 92% responded to the 2024 alumni survey.

1.The number, gender, technical programme and country of origin of postgraduate fellows are aggregated on the basis of internal programme data provided by the programme management.










