

Key findings of the 2018-2023 external evaluation of the four postgraduate training programmes operating under the GRÓ International Centre for Capacity Development, Sustainability and Societal Change. 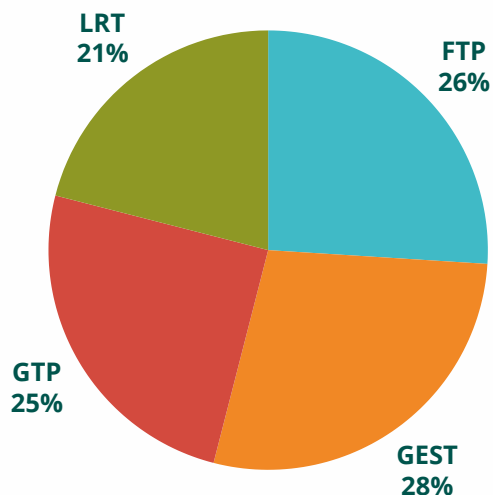

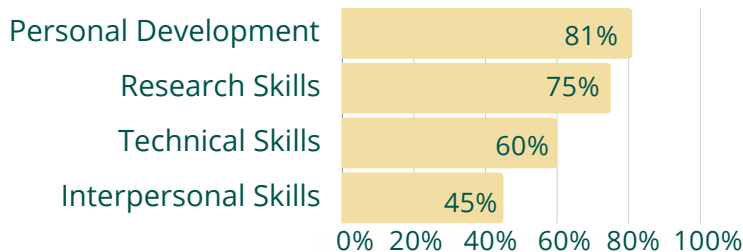

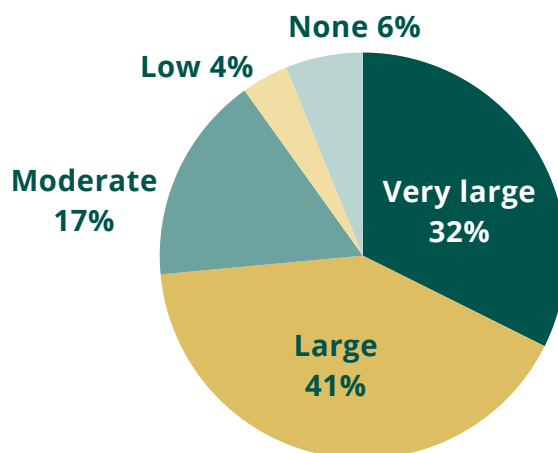
Professional advancement

80% of the fellows report improvements in their **personal development** due to the post-graduate programme³

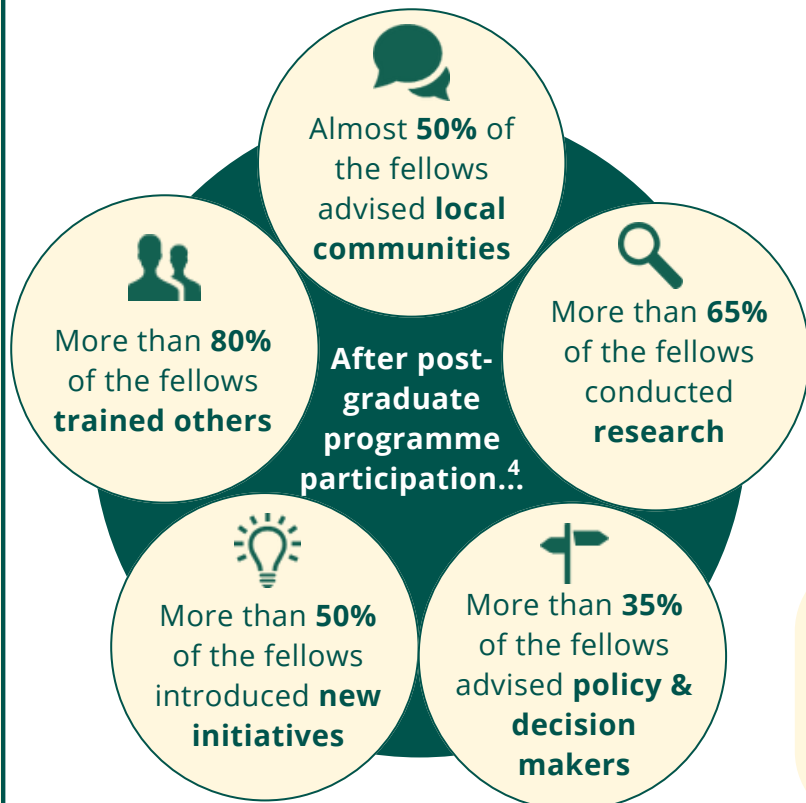


- Top 3** Career advancement of GRÓ graduates

 3. Salary increase

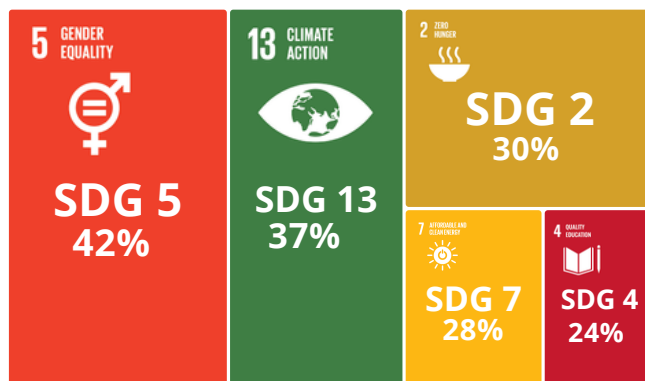
73% of the fellows report **large career advancements** due to the post-graduate programme³



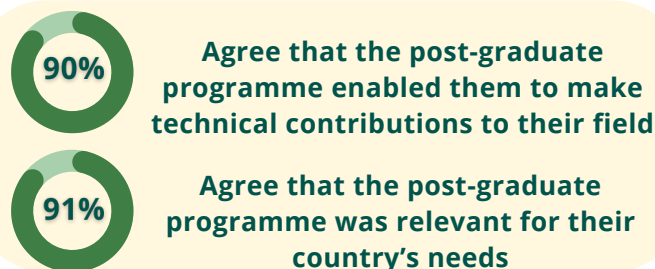
Contributions after graduation
